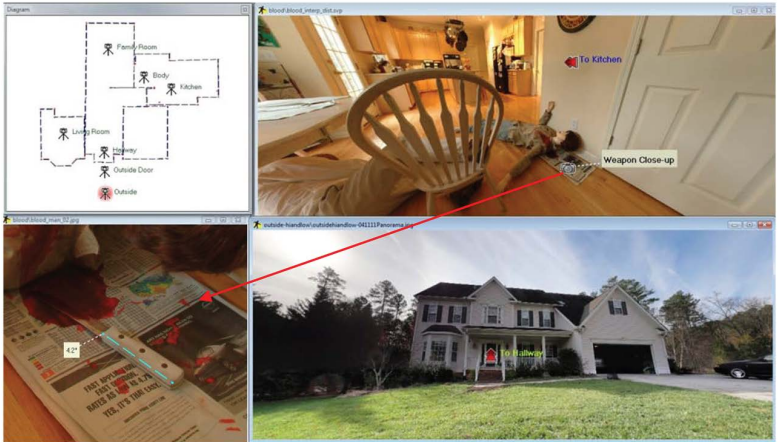


SceneVision - Panorama

With a variety of camera options, SceneVision Panorama is an easy-to-use, full-function Crime, Accident, and Fire Scene documentation software. Fast, Easy, Powerful and Inexpensive, SceneVision-Panorama will turn your individual photos and panoramas into a comprehensive crime, accident, or fire scene presentation.

The camera system we recommend is the fully automatic RoundShot Metric with Panomaker software. The photography process is fully automatic. Set up the camera, it takes the images, the Panomaker software organizes the images and creates the panoramas. The scene is ready for display and analysis.

Ingest these high-definition panoramas of the scene into SceneVision Panorama and you may begin to create a visually realistic, interactive, high-resolution report of the scene that can be made available in digital format with a freely distributable player to investigators, District Attorneys, Judges, the defense, and taken to court. You can enhance the scene in several ways: place portals in the scene to move through doorways from one panorama to another; hyperlink close-up photos (fingerprint images, weapons, wounds, blood spatter, etc.); add text documents, video, audio files to any location in the panoramas. Draw lines in the scene and label them with measurements taken at the scene.

- Animate "Walk-throughs" for automated courtroom presentations - just click and fly through the scene

- Draw Points and Lines in the photos and panoramas
- Data Processing Log records your steps in creating the presentation
